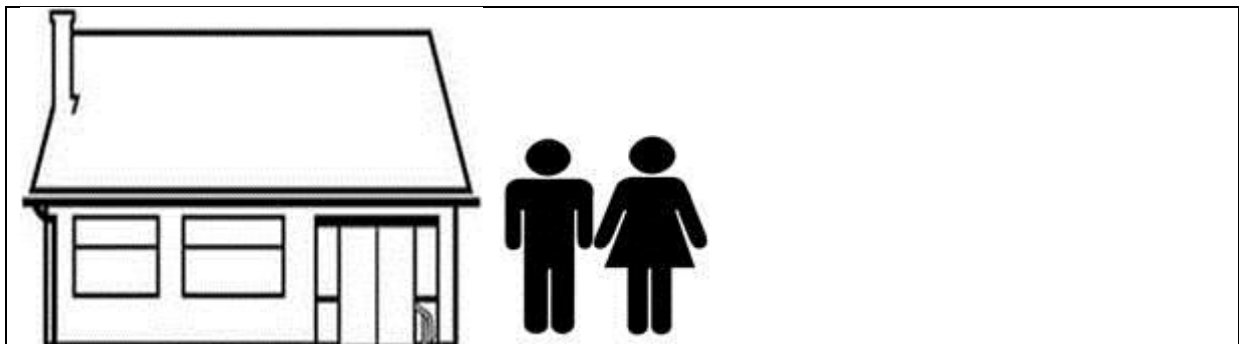

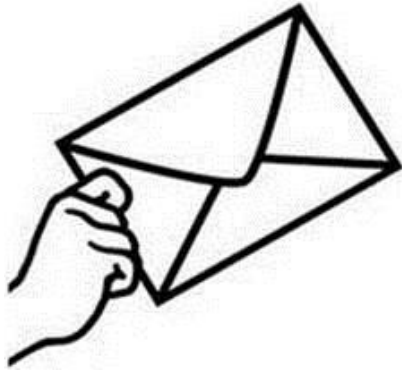

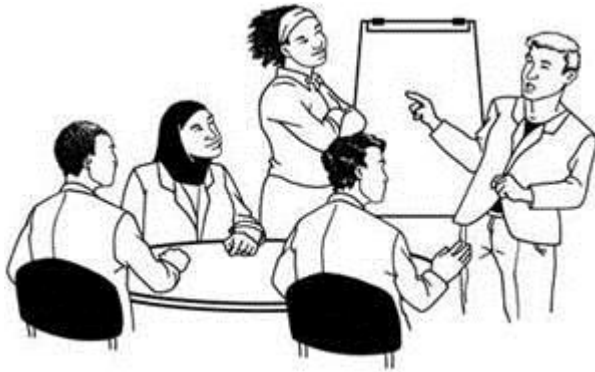

Working with the secure outreach transition team (SOTT)



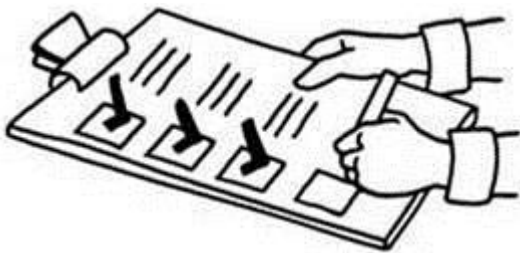
Your care team referred you to SOTT to seek advice and support to keep you safe and well in the community.

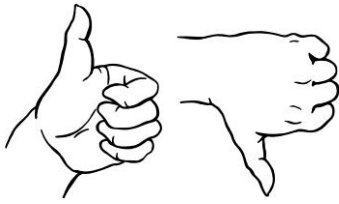
