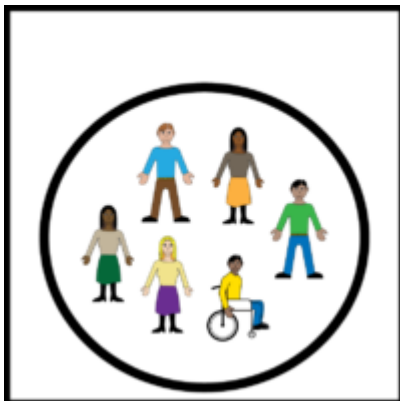




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

What is a transitions health facilitator?



	<p>A health facilitator is someone who helps you stay healthy</p>
	<p>We work with young people, with a learning disability, aged 14 -25.</p>

We aim to help:



How do we do this

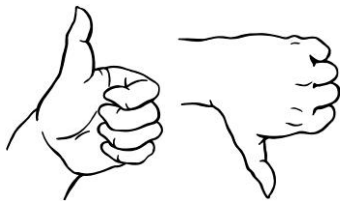
