

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What is a transitions health facilitator?

healthy and well	A health facilitator is someone who helps you stay healthy
	We work with young people, with a learning disability, aged 14 -25.

We aim to help:

transition	The transition from children's to adult services run smoothly
care for you	Make sure your health needs are met.


How do we do this

meeting	We make sure everyone who needs to, knows you are leaving or have left school.
understand	We help you understand what will happen after school or college and help you through that change.

help writing your plan	We help you to develop a health action plan.
my care	We make sure you are the most important person in planning your transition.


